

SAFE HOUSES

We have two safe houses in the capital of Uganda for underage, sexually abused and exploited girls. We provide the girls with a home, health care, therapy and counseling, in addition to helping them get back in school and paying their school fees. This year we have had 25 girls resettle into their home villages, and we sent 5 girls to University in the fall. We are so proud of their resiliency and ambition, and we are honored to be a part of their lives.



\$67,040 RAISED

We installed electricity at our school in Gulu, Uganda! A crowd of incredible friends put on fundraisers, spread the word, and brought the light to our campus! Electricity is changing everything for our students and staff!

PRIMARY SCHOOL

\$255,000 RAISED

We are almost finished building our new Primary School campus in Gulu, Uganda! This amazing new campus will be right across the street from Restore Leadership Academy and will be home to 500 wonderful little learners. There are not many places in Gulu for kids, so with your help, that is exactly what we are creating. We want our campus to be a place where these students can learn and grow, a space for kids to just be kids.

The Love Does School is now home to more than 600 Internally Displaced Peoples. The school is made up of Yazidi kids from Sinjar Mountain, Shabak kids from Mosul, and Arab kids from the Anbar province. All of our students are able to attend classes 5 days a week, and we bus all children living in IDP camps to the school. Our school is registered with the central government of Iraq, enabling the students to earn a certificate recognized by the Iraqi government. We have a wonderful school manager, Dilgash, 18 amazing teachers, and 2 school assistants that make this incredible place possible!

LOVE DOES VILLAGE

\$257,000 RAISED

We have been working in Northern Iraq for a few years now and have come to love many different people in this area. Some of our newest friends are the community of Syrian refugees who have been living in makeshift homes made up of tarps and shells of buildings. We all know how important it is for families to have a safe place to live and grow, and so we asked all of our friends to help us make a village. The support was incredible, and the village of 20 homes was born! Today the village is a lively center of this community, and you made it all possible. We cannot wait to see the effect of these homes for generations to come!



LOVE DOES HOSPITAL

\$1,000,000 RAISED

Construction is currently underway and we will be finished in the Spring of 2018! The hospital will serve the community of refugees in Northern Iraq who have been displaced by ISIS. Our friends from The Village Church in British Columbia raised more than one million dollars, and so many other supporters joined in the cause! All of this money is being used to build a beautiful facility that will heal and care for the amazing people of this region.

\$15,500 RAISED

Currently, 3 million people are suffering from dangerous levels of hunger due to severe back-to-back droughts in Somalia. Through the World Food Programme, we flew 11.5 tons of rice and cooking oil – enough to assist 50,000 people – to Kabasa and Kansale Camps in Dolow, Somalia.
