IRAQ



We returned to Iraq for the first time in about a year, and it was so wonderful to see how much has changed! This was the first time that we had been able to visit since since the completion of the Love Does Village. The development of community that we have seen since the creation of the Village has been truly awe-inspiring. These Syrian families have a chance to flourish rather than survive. The families that live in the Love Does Village do not pay rent, and their children are able to attend the nearby Love Does School. With help from all of our friends across the world, we hope that Kurdistan can continue to be a home for these refugee families that have been through so much!

The Love Does School is filled with wonderful IDP and refugee students. The goal of this school is to provide these displaced kids with the amazing education that they deserve, and to ensure that their lives are not permanently disrupted by the conflict. We have a remarkable teaching staff that fill the students up with love and information about the bright futures that they have waiting for them, and provide them with a space to just be kids.

As the community in Soran has evolved and settled, so have their needs. After starting the school and building the Love Does Village, the next need was a hospital. The hospital is a truly incredible place and is helping this community to rebuild and recover in ways that they could not before. One doctor told us, "You cannot imagine or expect what this means for the people here." For many displaced families this is the first medical care they have received in years, and it is instilling more hope and love than they could have dreamed of!
