## UGANDA



All schools in Uganda were formally closed by the government at the end of March, and our students and staff are safely home with their families. The teachers and staff at <u>Restore Leadership Academy</u> have been hard at work creating a distance learning plan and curriculum. Beginning in July, our teachers will distribute packets of notes and worksheets to each of our students every month. At the end of the month, the teachers will pick up the finished packets and pass out a new set. Though we wish we could have all of our students on campus, we are so proud of our teachers and students for their innovation, resilience and determination to make the best of these uncertain times. We are cheering them all on and are hopeful for progress and good news in the coming months!

Following the nationwide lock down in March, our team in Uganda began working with the local district officials to identify and supply food aid to the most vulnerable families in the community. In total, our team distributed a 30-day supply of food to 3,260 individuals. In addition to food distribution, we supplied 270 liters of disinfectant to the local markets, prisons and hospitals.

### SOMALIA



The babies in our <u>baby home</u> and women in our safe home are all healthy and well, and have been quarantined since the start of the pandemic. We are so grateful for the careful watch and love that our caretakers and nurses provide them, especially now!

Our new Girls Leadership Academy is nearly complete, and it is beautiful! Our team has been working hard to complete all of the final touches so that it can be ready for all of the girls to arrive when schools are able to resume.

Our team has also been working with the local authorities to distribute the 287,000 meals that arrived in our last shipping container. These meals have been an amazing resource to help the local community and families in the nearby IDP camps during these tough times.





#### **AFGHANISTAN**



Our school has been closed since the nationwide lockdown began at the end of March, and our students and staff are safely at home with their families. We have a big surprise for these students when they are able to come back to school, construction of our <u>new school</u> just finished! We were previously renting our school building, and are so excited to now have our very own. This new school building has two levels: On the first are office spaces, a teacher room, a laboratory and kitchen, and on the top there are eight classrooms. This building is designed to allow for growth over the next few years as we add a class level each year.

While the students have been away, our teachers and staff have been working hard to furnish and supply the new building to get ready for our students return. In addition, our staff have distributed stationery and textbooks to each of the students so they can continue to progress with their studies.

Many of our student's families rely on daily wages to provide the food and care they need, and the lockdown has made it difficult for many. We have worked with our team to provide two rounds of food and supplies to all of the families at our school. We are so grateful to each of you who make this care possible when it matters most!

# NEPAL



Nepal issued a nationwide lockdown at the end of March, and the girls in <u>our home and students at our school</u> have been home safely since. The four girls in our home are all happy and doing well. They have been keeping up with their schooling through online classes, and are all grateful to have the structure and normalcy that it brings. When they are not studying or working on school work, they can be found doing arts and crafts, learning yoga, playing games and listening to music. Their resilience and optimism has shown throughout, and we are always so proud of them!

The students at our primary school and after school program are all home with their families. We have sent each of them home with school supplies as well as food and scap for their families.

In addition to helping the families at our projects, our team has been working hard to help out in the local community. Many families rely on daily wages to provide for themselves, so we have been grateful to be able to offer some extra support and care. In total, our team has distributed food and disinfectant to 1,255 people in the community. We are so grateful to our team and to all of you who have reached out in care and support!





# INDIA



Our friends in India have been greatly impacted by the virus, and our thoughts and hopes go out to them all for a peaceful and healthy recovery soon.
