OUR SUPPORT

Following the nationwide lock down in March, our team in Uganda began working with the local district officials to identify and supply food aid to the most vulnerable families in the community. This food has been distributed to the following categories: people with disabilities, students at Gulu University who were unable to go home following the lockdown, boda boda drivers, vulnerable women in the sex trade, HIV positive individuals, private school teachers who have not had pay since the lockdown began in March, all students in our traditional healer program and all staff at our school.



THE DETAILS

In total, our team has distributed a 30-day supply of food to 5,708 individuals. In addition to food distribution, we have also supplied 270 liters of disinfectant to the local markets, prisons and hospitals. We have also printed out and distributed notes for hundreds of local students whose schools have not given them any curriculum.
